I. PURPOSE OF THE WORKSHOP

- 1. The Workshop on Statistical Data Dissemination and Communication will take place at the Palais des Nations, Geneva, Switzerland on 28-30 June 2017. In addition to the traditional presentations, the agenda of the workshop will include target-driven small group discussions, practical demonstrations and short presentations. Delegates will be asked to contribute to the development of internationally-coordinated work in the field of data dissemination and communication.
- 2. The target audience for the workshop includes senior and middle-level managers responsible for data dissemination and communication, across all statistical domains.

II. AGENDA OF THE WORKSHOP

- 3. The focus of the workshop will be on cutting edge ideas, new trends, experiments and approaches in the areas of data dissemination and communication.
- 4. The programme of the workshop will consist of the following substantive topics:
 - (i) Strategic communication planning
 - (ii) Measuring success and impact of communication programs (key performance indicators, web and social media analytics, measurement strategies)
 - (iii) Visions in data dissemination (e.g. open data, automated processes, strategies)
 - (iv) Novel uses of social media (new channels, strategies, emerging trends)
 - (v) Publishing and promoting digital content (automated publications, tools)
 - (vi) Presenting data in a simple way / Data visualisations (including geospatial data and maps)
 - (vii) Audience segmentation, personas and tailoring messages
 - (viii) Press and news media: adapting to today's media landscape

III. PARTICIPATION AND ACCREDITATION

- 5. Representatives of all Member States of the United Nations and of interested intergovernmental organizations are welcome to participate in the workshop. Participants representing non-governmental organizations in a consultative status with the United Nations Economic and Social Council may also attend. All participants must be accredited by the competent authorities of their country or international organization.
- 6. All participants attending the seminar are requested to have a valid passport and, if required, a visa. Applications for visas should be made as soon as possible to the Swiss Embassy in the country in which the participant resides, with reference to the UNECE Workshop on Statistical Data Dissemination and Communication. A letter to facilitate obtaining a visa can be requested from the UNECE secretariat.

- 7. Statistical offices and international organizations should inform the UNECE secretariat **by Friday 24 March 2017** if their organization intends to participate in the workshop.

 - A short abstract of the proposed contribution should be submitted by email to the UNECE secretariat, heini.salonen@unece.org and taeke.gjaltema@unece.org as soon as possible and by Friday 7 April 2017 at the latest. Information about the selection of contributions for the workshop, guidelines on formatting, and a reminder of deadlines will be sent to authors by email
 - Any written papers must be received by Friday 2 June 2017 at the latest.
 - Any **presentation** slides, videos or other electronic materials should be sent to the UNECE secretariat **by Friday 16 June 2017 at the latest**.
 - Any equipment required for practical demonstrations must be provided by the participants.
