









In the following decades the population decline will continue at rapid pace, and the annual decrease in population will fluctuate between 1.1-2%.



According to *population forecast*, by **the year 2035**:


- ➤ proportion of population of 60 years and more will increase from 18% in 2015 to 23.4%;
- number of children (0-14 years) and work age population (15-59 years) will decrease.



#### The use of the AAI in policy documents

The active ageing principle was used for Action Plan on Active Ageing (2017-2021) as part of the Road Map on Mainstreaming Ageing.

The AAI is to be used for monitoring the progress of the Action Plan on Active Ageing. As a result of the implementation of this Plan, the Government is estimating to increase the AAI by 25%.

#### Main objectives:

- ➤ To promote life-cycle approach towards ageing;
- To integrate ageing issues into all policy areas in order to adjust society and economy to the demographic changes and create a society for all ages;
- > To ensure the integration and full participation of elderly in society;
- To promote fair and sustainable economic growth as response to active ageing;
- > To adjust social protection system as a response to demographic changes and their social and economic costs;
- To promote lifelong learning;
- > To ensure the quality of life for all ages and maintain independent living, health and well-being of elderly.
