Instructions for completing individual parts of the questionnaire.

"Address" Section



The information in section "Address" shall be filled in according to the information recorded in the PNJ-2 form and the information available on site when visiting the dwelling or building.

The address of the enumerated dwelling shall be described as accurately as possible. After question A12. there is a field where additional information regarding the address can be described, such as: "the building is in an inner courtyard and cannot be seen from the street", "the dwelling is outside the building", etc.

Attention is needed when filling in fields A13. and A14. where the respective codes from form PNJ-2 for the enumerated dwelling are filled in.

"Building" Section



In the "Building" section information about the building subject to census shall be filled in. For buildings with more than one dwelling, section "Building" is filled in only in the questionnaire of the first dwelling.

"Dwelling" Section



In the section "Dwelling" the information about the dwelling subject to the census shall be filled in.

"Households" Section



In the "Households" section information on the households in the dwelling - subject of the Census, shall be provided. For more than one household in the dwelling a separate Census card should be filled in, and in the "Address" section the information from question A13. and A14. from the main Census card shall be copied, and sections "Building" and "Dwelling" and questions from H1. to H5. of section "Households" shall not be filled.

"Population" Section



In the "Population" section information about the persons - subject of the Census, shall be filled in. For more than 5 persons in one dwelling an additional Census card should be filled in, and in the "Address" section the information from question A13. and A14. from the main Census card shall be copied, and sections "Building", "Dwelling" and "Households" shall not be filled.

"Temporarily present persons" Section



In the "Temporarily present persons" section information about the persons temporarily residing in the dwelling - subject to the Census, shall be filled in. For more than 3 temporarily present persons in the dwelling, a separate "Temporarily present person" (TPP) card should be filled in for fourth and following temporarily present person. In this case in the "Address" section, the information from question A13. and A14. from the main Census card shall be copied.



Instructions for completing individual questions and their answers.

Fillable fields:



In the fields with dotted blue frame, the necessary information shall be filled in **in words or numbers** (for example: exact address, years, square meters, number, etc.). The information in these fields should be written clearly and legibly.



In the field with dotted blue frame and solid blue background the service codes necessary for the process of entering the information from the paper questionnaires into the Census Information System shall be filled in.



In the box with a dense blue frame the answer of the question shall be marked. **Only one answer is possible for the questions with such field before answers.**

The field is marked with or character.

Wrong by marked field is completely crossed out with a pen so that the background to become dense.

In the solid orange box the answers of the question shall be marked. **Only one answer is possible for questions with such field before answers.**

The field is marked with „X“ or „V“

Indicative fields or characters:



In blue or orange boxes containing a triangular note of caution, additional instructions or clarifications are given regarding the questions asked and possible answers.



Three arrows orange sign placed against a specific marking box gives instructions for moving to the next question or next section of the questionnaire.

Example: If you mark the answer "1. Student" to question P23., there is a sign with arrows indicating: Go to P27.

That means you don't have to ask questions P24., P25. and P26. to the enumerated person.
