





FAQ

Submitting a Census form was adjusted due to anti-epidemic measures:

How to submit a completed form?

You can submit a completed paper form in a reply envelope at a Census contact point, at any post office or simply via mailbox. You can obtain the envelope with Census 2021 logo together with a paper Census form from a Census enumerator or at the contact points. The envelope has a pre-printed address and postage is free of charge. Submit the completed Census form until 11 May 2021.

To obtain a new form for free, please contact the Census officer or visit the Census contact points. They are located at the selected Czech Post branches and the regional authorities of the Czech Statistical Office. To find the addresses, please refer to scitani.cz/kontaktnimisto or call the infoline at 253 253 683

Are there instructions for completing a form?

Basic instructions for completing are included in the form. For detailed instructions to complete all form sections, please refer to scitani.cz / formular. You may also call the infoline at 253 253 683 write to dotazy@scitani.cz.

Who is the form addressed to?

The form is addressed to all the people, including those temporarily absent, who share a dwelling and have not participated in online Census yet.

What about those who have enumerated yourself via internet (online)?

In case your entire household has been enumerated online, you do not need to fill in the paper form.

In case only some members from your household have been enumerated online, please provide all the data on housing and households A1 – A13 on pages 2 to 5 when filling in the paper form. Please mark the enumerated household members with a cross in the list of persons on page 4, question A10. For the rest of the form, question B1 – B16 from page 6, please fill in only for members, who had not enumerated online.

Does everyone need to fill in the form separately?

The form may be completed by a single person for the entire household.

Who should fill in the form for minors and persons with diminished responsibility?

Parents and guardians are obliged to fill in the data for minors or persons with diminished responsibility.

Is it mandatory to answer all questions?

It is mandatory to answer all questions according to the instructions in the form (e.g. some data is to be filled in only by persons of age 15 and over, etc.). The only exceptions are questions on nationality (B9) and religious beliefs (B10), for which the answer is not obligatory.



Please complete according to the current status as of 26.03.2021

For the Census results it is important that everybody completes data by the same moment. Please complete all data as of 26th March 2021 (more specifically, according to the state as of the midnight between Friday the 26th and Saturday the 27th of March 2021), unless specified otherwise at the questions.

Complete with black or blue ink.

Please use black or blue pens, in order for the data to be read correctly.

Complete with a ballpoint pen.

Why use a ballpoint pen? Markers may soak through, ink might leak out, pencils and black crayons may be invisible or too bold to read.

Please use the names of municipalities and states as of 26.03.2021, since they may change. Use the same procedure for the names of regions and districts.

Please align the letters to the right.

In some areas, numbers will need to be filled in. If there are more fields than you need, please write the number on the right side, unless otherwise specified.

Use capital letters.

If everyone completes the forms in capital block letters according to our specimen, the 2021 Census results will be available sooner.

Please write in the specified fields only.

Each field should contain only one letter including hooks, commas, one number or other characters. Do not write anything outside white fields. The machines can read only the content inside. Please keep this in mind.

Please mark the correct answer with an X.

If there are more items to choose from, please mark your choice with an X. Please mark only one option with an X unless otherwise specified.

Please black out wrong answers.

In case you make a mistake, for example put X in a wrong field or write a wrong letter, cross it out completely and write the correct answer. Please do not try to overwrite it.





E6 – Educational attainment: Persons who gained their education in a foreign educational institution or a private educational institution without the accreditation by the Ministry of Education shall state the corresponding education level in the Czech Republic educational system if their education is acknowledged as equal. **Basic education:** Shall be stated by persons who have finished their special needs classes, practical school, special primary school, former burgher school, civil school or the working degree of special needs classes. 


