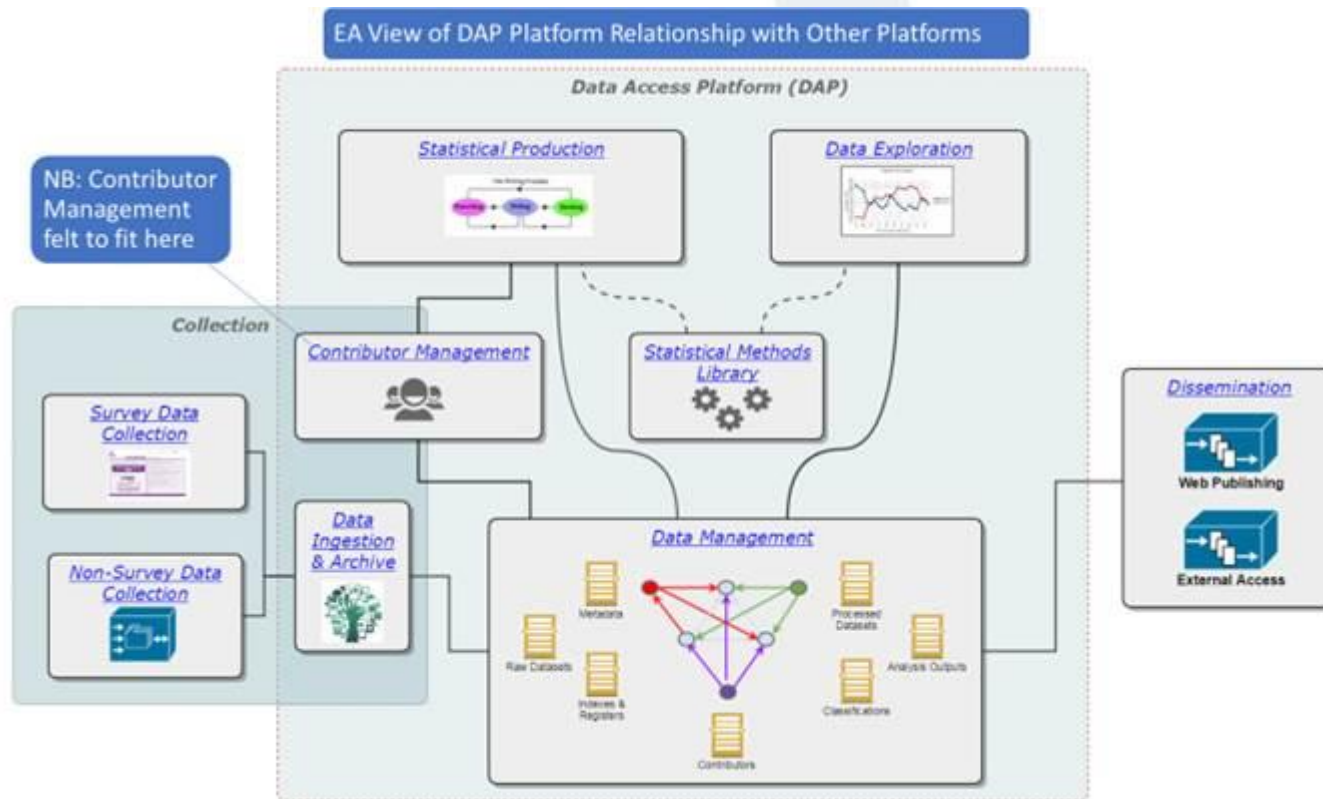

# Coordinated sampling in the UK

---

- Benefits clear, theory exists but no comprehensive strategy
  - Implemented unilaterally for rotation/subsampling, when slowing rotation rate/reducing sample size
  - Coordination across legacy surveys & in real-time
- Local issues
  - GB\* compliance burden (Osmotherly, 1980)
  - IDBR<sup>25</sup> selects RUs, not enterprise or legal unit
  - IDBR<sup>25</sup> pseudo-random number generator flawed - but consistently so
  - ... but SBR will rule them all, find them, bind them
