



Coordinated sampling in the UK

- Benefits clear, theory exists but no comprehensive strategy
 - Implemented unilaterally for rotation/subsampling, when slowing rotation rate/reducing sample size
 - Coordination across legacy surveys & in real-time
- Local issues
 - GB* compliance burden (Osmotherly, 1980)
 - o IDBR²⁵ selects RUs, not enterprise or legal unit
 - IDBR²⁵ pseudo-random number generator flawed
 but consistently so
