Concept	Tertiary Students -
Definition	<p>Tertiary students are those enrolled in level 5A, 5B or 6 of the ISCED* 1997 for the academic year concerned.</p> <p>Level 5A corresponds to tertiary programmes that are largely theoretically based and are intended to provide sufficient qualifications for gaining entry into advanced research programmes and professions with high skill requirements.</p> <p>Level 5B corresponds to tertiary programmes that are practically oriented/occupationally specific and are mainly designed for participants to acquire practical skills.</p> <p>Level 6 is reserved for tertiary programmes leading to the award of an advanced research qualification.</p> <p>* International Standard Classification of Education</p>
