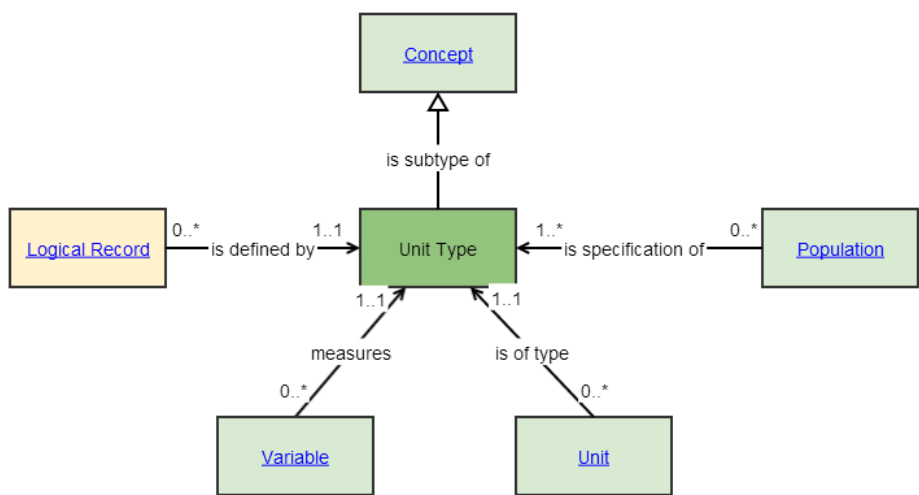

Uni t Ty pe	Co nc epts	A <i>Unit Type</i> is a class of objects of interest	<p>A <i>Unit Type</i> is used to describe a class or group of <i>Units</i> based on a single characteristic, but with no specification of time and geography. For example, the <i>Unit Type</i> of "Person" groups together a set of <i>Units</i> based on the characteristic that they are 'Persons'.</p> <p>It concerns not only <i>Unit Types</i> used in dissemination, but anywhere in the statistical process. E.g. using administrative data might involve the use of a fiscal unit.</p>	Object class (ISO 11179)
